Bernard 'Sales' into Parish Council

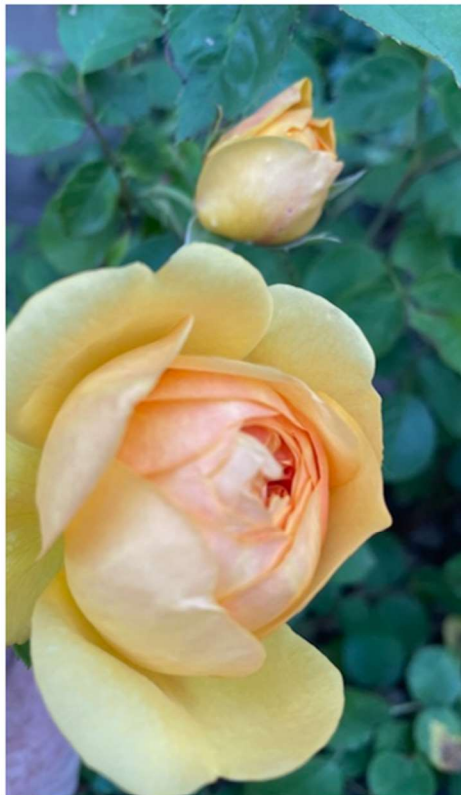
